Communication from the CARE (Communicating and Responding Effectively) Advisory Team

The coronavirus pandemic presents a dynamic, uncertain, and ever-changing set of circumstances. For these reasons, the FUMC CARE Advisory Team was formed.

Mission Statement of the CARE Team:

The mission of the CARE Team is to advise and support church leadership and membership regarding actions the church should take to operate safely in these times. This committee is using information from various trusted sources, including guidance from the United Methodist Churches of Minnesota.

The team will evaluate all recommendations and assure that decisions:

Demonstrate the value we place on the health and safety of all worshippers, visitors, and staff.

Align with trusted and authoritative sources of information including the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) and the Minnesota Department of Health (MDH).

Include safe implementation of all recommendations relating to worship.

Fighting the Good Fight:

As the month of May draws to a close, we recognize that we have not been able to worship together in person for more than two months. Still, we can celebrate our continued focus on our mission of growing in love toward God and our neighbors, reaching new people, and helping to heal a broken

world. Many of us have demonstrated our love and care for each other in and outside of our faith community. We continue to be amazed by the many acts of kindness we have seen and heard. We continue to prove that we are capable, resilient, and can persevere in these wild and crazy circumstances. Although we look forward to reconvening together, we are not planning to reopen for indoor worship for the foreseeable future. Transmissions and deaths caused by the virus continue to rise, and physical distancing is the best prevention method to stop the spread of the virus.

The FUMC CARE Team exists to regularly evaluate the situation. These meetings will be convened twice per month, or as needed, given the changing circumstances.

We are delighted to learn that our church staff and members will begin to work towards planning three outdoor worship services on the last Sunday of each month: June 28, July 26, and August 30. Look for other announcements soon about new ways we plan to safely connect, love, and share with one another. From the pastor...

Dear Friends,

"I thank my God every time I remember you, constantly praying with joy in every one of my prayers for all of you." Philippians 1:3-4

I love how the Apostle Paul begins his letter to the congregation he started in the city of Philippi. Significantly, Paul wrote this letter from prison, and there is little doubt he was greatly encouraged in his struggles by remembering and voicing his gratitude for all the blessings he had received in and through this church.

Recent research has testified to the power of gratitude. From strengthening our immune systems and helping us sleep better to creating more energy and providing a greater sense of connection, gratitude has been linked to an incredible number of positive outcomes. The research suggests two reasons for this. First, during periods of hardship, it's easy to think there is no other reality than the difficult one we are experiencing in the moment. Articulating our gratitude helps us put present challenges in a broader context and avoid a negative "tunnel vision." Second, voicing our gratitude connects us powerfully with others, reminding us that we are not alone but joined deeply and meaningfully to others.

We are at a fragile time in our struggle against the coronavirus, as we move from the crisis-response of the first few weeks to recognizing that we are in this for the long-haul. Even as we move to returning to more normal life, we are also realizing that the new normal will be guite different from what we experienced even a few short months ago. It is at just this point that we may lose confidence or be tempted to despair. One way to bolster our spirits and renew our sense of hope is by naming our gratitude, counting our blessings, and remembering all that is good in life.

So what can you give thanks for today? And whom can you thank? Whether by text, phone call, email, or letter, you have an opportunity to name your blessings, be renewed in confidence, and bolster the spirits of another. As you do so, know that I, like Paul, "thank my God every time I remember you, constantly praying with joy in every one of my prayers for all of you!"

Church Council Minutes

May 19, 2020

Council Members Present: Pastor Dale, Wendy Vanderwerf, Donn Arnold, Adrienne Stegmeir, Erin Thorvaldson, Emily Honerbrink, Scott Lecy, Cheryl Lecy, Tom Ervasti, Juanita Morgan

The May meeting was conducted via Zoom; opened with a prayer led by Pastor Dale.

As we potentially near closer to being able to worship together again, it is important that we have a detailed plan for safely resuming worship - the council discussed and agreed to appoint a "Smart" team to lead the creation of a phased plan. The following comes from the suggestion of the Bishop:

I urge each congregation to create a "smart team" if that has not already happened. This planning group might include members with public health expertise, those from the medical and health professions, leaders from public safety or schools, as well as your pastor and other key staff. The smart team knows your context, your members at greater risk, and the physical dimensions of your facilities inside and outside your building. The smart team will help think through the details that will need to be in place when it is time to reopen for activities like worship, funerals, weddings or small group activities.

The council chose 6 individuals to serve on the team alongside Pastor Dale. As of these minutes, four individuals have confirmed: Rebecca Ervasti, Mark Vanderwerf, Ashley Nelson and Donn Arnold. These members will create a plan and present it to the Council. Until the plan is in place, and until restrictions are lifted by Minnesota, we will continue to meet virtually. If you have any suggestions or ideas for future services you are encouraged to send them in!

The Council also agreed to let **Carol** increase her hours, if she feels comfortable doing so.

Missions: A few calls came in for helping with the cemetery. Mark V. has been out cleaning up the area. June is MN Adult and Teen Challenge; July is Brush with Kindness. Scott Lecy has been in contact with Teen Challenge. Several ideas were presented for how we can engage with the group as we've done in the past. The Council decided to use the virtual ministry option; this will be incorporated into the June 21 sermon.

Finances: Finances for April were better than March. Giving was lower, but expenses were also lower. Giving for April exceeding April 2019. Very grateful! As a reminder, there are multiple ways you can send in your offerings, including through mail, automatic withdrawals through a bank account or by using tith.ly.

SPRC Update: Committee met May 17th. **Carol's** retirement is on schedule for July 31st. Will have future celebration. SPRC approved the job description; still need to decide hours. Position will be posted on FUMC website initially; will be posted public at a later date.

Additional notes:

Please think about those living alone during these trying times. A simple phone call is greatly appreciated, as well as dropping off books or sending a note. We're all in this together!

Meeting was adjourned with a prayer led by **Scott Lecy.**

Do you or someone you know need temporary medical equipment?

HELP offers used medical equipment to anyone with a temporary need. The equipment can be "borrowed" for up to six months, but can be extended with a phone call for another six months – for a total borrow time of one year. After that, the equipment will need to be returned. The equipment is housed at First UMC.
