Join us **Wednesday** evenings starting September 30th and throughout October at 6pm around the campfire at the pavilion.


Bring your lawn chair, blankets and s'more fixings for a fun evening worshipping with friends and family.

From the pastor...

Dear Friends,

"I thank my God every time I remember you, constantly praying with joy in every one of my prayers for all of you."



These words of the Apostle Paul to his beloved congregation in Philippi capture so well my thoughts and prayers for all of you, never more so than during this season of unprecedented and unforeseen challenges. During this time, God has helped us endure as he continues to provide all that we need from day to day. God is good ... all the time!

For example, over the past six months, Sunday worship has averaged just over 100 views a week when combining our Vimeo and Facebook platforms. While it's hard to estimate the number of persons represented by a "view," even a modest estimate – multiplying it by 1.5, for instance - would represent a larger virtual attendance than we have had physically at any time of the year, let alone during the summer, in a really long time for our congregation. I am grateful that our online worship services are reaching more people than otherwise would be reached.

Also, your financial giving, for the most part, has remained consistent (Thank you!) and has enabled us to continue with important staffing and facility needs. Most programmatic funding has been put on hold during our suspension of in-person worship, groups, and activities. The decrease in income we've been noticing year-to-date, is likely the result of the dramatic decrease (57K) in financial pledges we learned of last Fall. Yet, despite such a significant decrease in funding, with adjustments made to spending, we are still able to pay our bills. However, with decreased giving and entering in to the cold weather season resulting in higher utility expenses, it will likely become more uncertain for us financially. As always, if you are able to give more, please pray about it and follow the Spirit's lead. Thank you.

Finally, our C.A.R.E. Team will continue making decisions about Sunday worship on a monthly basis and, for the month of October, will continue to suspend gathering in-person indoors. This decision, as with all others, has been made in accord with our commitments to listen to the best advice from our health professionals, prioritize the safety of our members, and witness to our faith in God by obeying Christ's command to "love your neighbor," even when that means making sacrifices.

I recognize that not having in-person worship has been one such sacrifice, and I assure you that all of our decisions are made with both great care and prayer. I also recognize that some churches have returned or will soon be returning to in-person indoor worship. As we've seen in the world of education, business, sports, and entertainment, different organizations may reach different decisions in response to their own distinct circumstances and commitments. Similarly, we are trying to make decisions that seem best for our own little community of faith. Thank you for understanding.

I will close where I began, with tremendous gratitude for each of you who make up our congregation. Your faith, your patience, your hopefulness, your generosity, and your willingness to sacrifice in service to our neighbors has been inspiring, and God continues to be at work through all these things for the sake of this world God loves so much. We will get through this. We will get through this together. And, by God's grace, we will come out stronger on the other side. Until that time, know that I hold you in prayer, always with thanksgiving.

Pastoral Care


Hospitals no longer telephone churches, because of the privacy act, to let us know that one of our members have been admitted.

Contributions

When one becomes a member of FUMC, you declare a covenant with the church that you will support its ministries with your time and money. We have several options now available to receive your monetary contributions:

- 1. Sunday am offering plates
- 2. Mail your check to the church office
- 3. On-line bill pay via your bank or credit union. There typically is no fee for this service.
- 4. On-line giving via Tithe.ly. There is a link on our website and an app is available for your phone or computer. There is a fee for this option. During the payment process, the contributor decides whether the credit card service fee comes out of the gift or if the service fee is above what is contributed. You can indicate if you want your gift to go to something other than the General Fund.
- 5. Gift-in-kind: If you purchase anything for the church or a church event that would normally be paid out of the General Fund/budget, provide a receipt and it will be entered on your contribution statement. Examples would be: computer supplies, bell music, snow removal, SS supplies, etc.

When contributing, if you don't state what the gift is for, we assume the donation is for use against the budget or General Fund. If you want the gift given for a specific purpose, i.e., missions, please state that on your check and we will ensure to direct it to that purpose.

September 2020

The Council did not meet in September; below is the September Pastor's report:

September 2020, Pastor's Report

Virtual Annual Conference Session via Zoom - August 29 - If interested, members can read summary of the Session at the MN Annual Conference website (www.minnesotaumc.org)

Monthly C.A.R.E. Team Meetings - Continue to meet with the C.A.R.E. Team to evaluate and re-evaluate current Covid-19 updates and recommendations as they relate to churches, specifically our own congregation. I am thankful for the wisdom and care and compassion that this team uses when we meet. They love this congregation and are making careful and prayerful decisions in its best interest. We have currently decided to continue with outdoor/drive-in worship as long as weather allows (hopefully through October). They are looking into other possible outings for church members to get together safely with one another for fellowship and fun. Stay tuned.

In-Person/Online Bible Study Options - Have been working on both in-person and online Bible study options for the month of September. Will be studying the book of James. No one signed up for the first inperson Bible study as they were requested to do, so it did not happen. We will try again on 9/23. Again, members should be sure to sign up in advance by calling the church office if they want to attend. Online Zoom Bible study is scheduled to begin on Monday, September 27. Members should contact church office for Zoom link/invitation.

On-going Outdoor/Drive-In Worship - Throughout August and continuing through October Sunday morning worship will continue to be held outdoors in the parking lot and in front of pavilion. I am grateful for this opportunity for all who volunteer to make it happen each week.

No Sunday School or Confirmation - There will be no Sunday School or Confirmation classes offered this Fall. Weekly Sunday School Resources will be available via a link on our church website for families who choose to participate from home.

Fun Around the Fire - I'm excited about a new weekly opportunity for members of all ages that we

are simply calling, "Fun Around the Fire". This will be held around our fire pit near the church playground on Wednesday nights at 6:00 p.m. and will include opportunities for singing, eating (bring own food), playing, and praying. This was another C.A.R.E. Team idea for which I am grateful.

On-going Pastoral Care - I have been trying to stay connected with members as best I can. Please contact me if you would like a visit or phone call. I can bring communion to homes if needed.

Finance Update - August did not look much different than the previous six months, expenses exceeded giving totals even though it was a five Sunday month. The checking account balance continues to lose ground and is beginning to be a concern. Nearly every FUMC expense is normal overhead, cost of doing business expense and we are very limited in what we can choose not to pay for should minimal giving continue much longer.

Giving totals for September so far -- we are currently at \$3,355. That is far short of the COVID-19 average of \$11,879 in giving and \$12,851 in expenses. Nearly \$1,000 difference each month since March.


Hope Circle
