Mission Focus: Feed My Starving Children

First United Methodist Church, Lindstrom is making a difference for the kingdom of God every month through missions giving and service. This month we are supporting Feed My Starving Children.

Every year, millions of children die from preventable causes such as pneumonia, diarrhea, malaria and undernutrition. Hunger is still causing nearly half of deaths in children under 5 years old. From this data, we estimate at least 6,200 children die each day from causes related to undernutrition. This is heartbreaking.

Feed My Starving Children (FMSC) believes hope starts with food. As a Christian nonprofit, FMSC is dedicated to seeing every child whole in body and spirit. FMSC works with food distribution partners that stay with communities for the long haul, empowering them to move from relief to development.

FMSC meals are developed by food science and nutrition professionals to supplement nutritional needs and reduce problems with malnutrition. Nutrition allows children to grow, thrive and develop to their full potential.

How much can we raise together to help feed children in body and spirit this month?

\$88 feeds a child for a year

\$365 feeds a family for a year

\$1,866 provides a pallet of food

\$10,000 feeds a village

- Ended January around \$18,000 February at \$42,000 that includes a pledge from 2020 and 2021 as well as \$10,000 grant.
- The last time an audit was completed was 2000, looking for a 3rd party to complete this in the near future.
- Payments to apportionments will be paid for January and February.
- In has been some time since there as been a pay increase for the custodian, with current extra cleaning and amount of time, all agreed a raise is much need. Sarah Sandgren is also coming up on one year and would like to also give a raise. All agreed upon. It will start first pay day next quarter.

YOUTH:

Announcements

- The General Church Conference is postponed to 2022, with online Special Session in 2021. The Commission on the General Conference just announced its decision to further postpone the 2020 General Conference until Aug. 29 - Sept. 6, 2022 in Minneapolis, as the COVID-19 pandemic continues to affect the safety of mass gatherings and travel. In response to the further postponement, the Council of Bishops (COB) is calling a Special Session of the General Conference to be convened online on May 8, 2021. The purpose of the 2021 Special Session will be limited to gaining a quorum in order to suspend the rules for the sole purpose of allowing the use of paper ballots to act upon 12 pieces of legislation that would enable the church to effectively continue its work until the postponed 2020 General Conference is held in 2022.
- Confirmation class will continue on Wednesday evenings from 5:30-7pm. The last day of Confirmation will be Wednesday, May 12th. Confirmation Sunday is May 16th.
