# Sunday School

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Church Council Meeting
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August 17, 2021

The August meeting was opened with a devotional from Terry Kopp based on 2 Peter 3:8

Motion to approve agenda – motion passed Motion to approve Consent Agenda – motion passed

Old business:

Council at Large positions: 1 filled (Boni Stockel); 1 open

**Council meeting process, devotions:** Change to way meeting minutes are handled, council secretary (Emily) to send minutes out to entire council prior to publishing. Minutes are considered approved if no response by given deadline. Opening devotions to be done on a rotation between council members. Terry to send council agendas prior to each meeting.

**SPR children's proposal update:** Job description created, floated by outside acquaintances. Dialogue with District Supervisor. Strategic plan should have children's ministry hire involved. Peter to send job description to council; current job description calls for 24 hours/week.

**Computer/tech support:** Two bids in from BitWorks and Primo Technology. Same monthly fee (\$30), similar startup fee (\$1,000). Motion to pick one and move forward. *Motion Passed*.

**Memorials List:** Emails sent to committee chairs looking for needs for Memorials to support. Deadline for wish-list ask is September 1st; each committee asked to submit five requests. Committee to meet in September to decide which items to move forward with. Committee also looking at creating a brochure with Church needs listed to give to those who are looking to donate on behalf of loved ones.

**Finance Committee:** 1997 policy set up so that any Memorials/ Special Gifts given to Church are divided three ways (between Memorials, General Fund and Foundation). Motion to change policy so that any undesignated funds go 100% into Memorial fund. *Motion Passed*. Two undesignated Memorial accounts set up as individual line items: Doris Brand and Vi Strand. Motion to turn over both funds to Memorial Fund. *Motion Passed*.

#### New Business:

**Strategic Planning:** Council had a good discussion about how to approach the creation of a strategic plan for the Church. Conference suggested we should consider outside help – council agrees. Terry to contact district superintendent to start mini Healthy Church Initiative (HCI) conversation. Discussion about waiting to move forward with Children's Ministry position until after strategic planning, or do both simultaneously. Next council meeting: Terry to add job description to agenda as a line item; Peter to look at marketing costs and compensation. Understanding that we need to include in yearly budget discussions, but initial position could be funded by a grant from the Foundation.

Meeting closed with Prayer. Next meeting September 21st, committee reports due by September 16th.

The following reports were submitted to the Council Secretary prior to the meeting:

SPRC: Does not meet until 8/16

Finance: Does not meet until 8/17

**Trustees:** Trustees did not meet this month; our next meeting is September14,

2021 6:30 pm. Although we have not met we are communicating through email, text and phone calls; the following is what is going on.

- Trustees have accepted bid from DKU Construction from North Branch to repair sidewalks on the north, north east of the church and to form a pad for garbage containers at a cost of \$6,470.00. Lloyd is working to obtain the funds for project.
- Our church bell does not work, Lloyd is talking with a rep. from Verdin Bells & Clocks to obtain a cost of repair, hoping to have something by the end of this month.
- During the summer we had leak in the skylight in sanctuary which has been repaired by Lake Area Roofing at a cost of \$1600.00. We also signed a roof maintenance program with them at a cost of \$1200.00 year because of the age of our roof.
