Fall Bible Studies

Thursday mornings at 10:15am:

DISCIPLE: a program of disciplined Bible study aimed at developing strong Christian leaders. The study gives the Old and New Testaments equal time emphasizing the wholeness of the Bible as a revelation of God.

DISCIPLE draws upon the work of scholars, the personal Bible reading and study of the participant, and dynamic group discussion to aid understanding of the Bible.

The first study in the program is DISCIPLE: Becoming Disciples through Bible Study. It serves as the basis for all other studies in the DISCIPLE family that follow. Over the course of 34 weeks, the study covers the entire Bible (Old and New Testaments) following the biblical story from Creation to the New Jerusalem.

A small fee accompanies this class to cover the study materials.

Thursday evenings from 7pm-8:30pm :

"The Armor of God" is an 8 week study led by Terry Kopp - drawn heavily from a study authored by Rev. Glenn Polzine. (No class on October 20th).

This is a study of Ephesians 6:10-18 and multiple related scriptural references. We will explore, discuss and learn about the tools a Christian needs to navigate the challenges of a life of faith. Weekly topics include truth, righteousness, the gospel, faith, salvation, and the Spirit.

New to faith in Christ, established followers, seekers and anyone in between can benefit from this study.
