Mission Focus:

First United Methodist Church, Lindstrom, is making a difference for the kingdom of God every month through missions giving and service. This month we are supporting Feed My Starving Children.

From their website: "Every year, millions of children die from preventable causes such as pneumonia, diarrhea, malaria and undernutrition. Hunger is still causing nearly half of deaths in children under 5 years old. From this data, we estimate at least 6,200 children die each day from causes related to undernutrition. This is heartbreaking.

Feed My Starving Children (FMSC) believes hope starts with food. As a Christian nonprofit, FMSC is dedicated to seeing every child whole in body and spirit. FMSC works with food distribution partners that stay with communities for the long haul, empowering them to move from relief to development.

FMSC meals are developed by food science and nutrition professionals to supplement nutritional needs and reduce problems with malnutrition. Nutrition allows children to grow, thrive and develop to their full potential."

How much can we raise together to help feed children in body and spirit this month?

\$88 feeds a child for a year

\$365 feeds a family for a year

\$1,866 provides a pallet of food

\$10,000 feeds a village


