Statement of Financial Position – Current checkbook balance. \$43,901.97. Apportionments on hold. Will evaluate 1Q at next meeting. We received a letter from conference acknowledging 3 years of full payments. Current balance for Doris Brand trust account \$22,697.09. Savings \$46,533.31. Total expenses \$13,913.50 (budget \$15,980.02).

Statement of Activities – February offering \$31,126.67 (budget \$15,980.13). The \$7,500 (less expenses) grant remains allocated to account 404. The money remains targeted for Children's Ministry position.

- Dedicated Accounts The rainy-day fund remains at \$8,000. The general savings has \$4888.61. Total \$12,888.61.
- III. New Business

Account 579 License and Fees increased significantly. Two have been paid and both were over

previous year expenses (\$200 increase each).

Account 631 Gas & Electricity may have a credit next month for a rate adjustment.

Pastor Medical deductions are under review. Lloyd will check with SPRC on split between personal and church paid.

Pastor pension is under review. The charges don't exactly match the premiums, etc. Lloyd is

checking into it.

Workers Compensation: The District will no longer be providing group workers compensation

options effective January 2025. We have plenty of time to add work compensation to our

insurance coverage.

Office computer: Lloyd is requesting more people be able to access and use the Perisoft

computer program.

IV. Old Business

Fundraising: General question on miscellaneous funds brought in by special events. Examples include Children's Shop Day and Living Nativity. Suggestion is to review/edit Financial Control Policy at the January Finance Meeting as it relates to fundraising events. Will include for February meeting. Delayed to April. Super Bowl donations went to the Masonic Lodge for matching funds to Pathways.

Missions: Lloyd found a correction for missions donations for Zoe International. He will provide an update at next meeting. Lloyd will clear with Pastor and close this item.

Children's Ministry: The Finance committee is authorizing up to \$800 per month for Children's Ministry Leader for the next six months. The funding will be evaluated with additional feedback from SPRC. Funds will be drawn from the 2022 Children's Ministry Grant with potential funding from discretionary funds account 902 and 905. Motion passed.

Childrens Ministry Grant – income \$7,500. Funds have been allocated towards advertising, VBS materials and other children's ministry programs. Recommendation is to pursue the second half of the \$15,000 based on our children and youth ministry programs. Examples include VBS, Sunday School, Children's Shop Day, KICK, children's bibles, etc. Verna and Lloyd will package our efforts and submit to the conference for second half consideration.

Financial Control Policy – needs update to reflect: Dedicated accounts, Tithe.ly, Paypal and Offering Counter procedures.

Bi-Annual account audit will be scheduled for 2Q.
