Dear Friends in Christ,

Over the past week, our communities in the Dakotas-Minnesota Episcopal Area and our neighbors in Northwest Iowa have faced significant challenges due to unexpected flooding. These natural disasters have brought severe disruptions to the lives of many, causing damage to homes, businesses, and critical infrastructure. In these trying times, our faith and unity become our greatest strengths.

As your bishop, my heart aches for those affected by these floods. The scenes of rising waters, evacuated homes, and distressed families weigh heavily on all of us. Yet, it is precisely in such moments of trial that the essence of our faith shines the brightest. The resilience, compassion, and solidarity displayed by our congregations and neighbors serve as a testament to the enduring power of our shared commitment to Christ's teachings—I'm particularly thinking of Matthew 25. May the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with us all as we respond to this challenge with unwavering faith and collective action.
