

II. Review Statements Statement of Financial Position —Current checkbook balance. \$26,118.56. First quarter apportionments paid. 2Q remains on hold as of August. Will review at September meeting. Potential for apportionments to be held long term if giving doesn't pick up the second half of the year. Current balance for Doris Brand trust account \$24,720.08. Savings \$40,796.44.

Statement of Activities – July offering \$13062.15.

(budget \$15,748.19). Total expenses
\$13,527.53 (budget \$15,998.19).). June
was better than May, however, overall
cash flow is concerning – we are tracking
approximately \$2,500 below monthly
where we need to be on an annual basis.
YTD shortfall \$9,500 gross revenue.

Dedicated Accounts – Youth camp has a balance of \$1,802.34. All requests have been paid. The rainy-day fund remains at \$8,000. The general savings has \$5,049.43. Total \$13,308.61.

Expenses are inline with "normal" activities.

III. New Business

Budget – Lloyd passed out a budget worksheet. We will begin working on 2025 budgets next month. Key is getting the word out to the committees to start thinking about their budgets.

Continued.

Electronic sign – discussion around promoting and communicating with local travelers with on-going programs and activities. Thoughts on how to raise money for an electronic sign. Question if the foundation can provide funding. Next step – find out if there's a procedure to request foundation support.

IV. Old Business

Community Meal – we received a letter requesting an annual donation from each of five churches – estimated at \$100/month. The request is to have outreach request funding from finance with an official request. It can be carved into the 2025 budget for outreach. This has been passed on to the Outreach committee.

Christmas Dinner – we currently have \$622.44 in the dedicated account. Lloyd will check with Dorothy on plans. This remains open. Last year this event was held as part of the Monday community event. This year Christmas Day is on a Wednesday. This remains open pending a team leader.

Bi-Annual audit needs to be completed – target August 1.

Financial Control Policy – needs update to reflect: <u>Dedicated accounts,</u> <u>Tithe.ly, Paypal and Offering Counter procedures.</u>

Job Description: Church Accompanist

Position Title: Church Piano Player

Location: First United Methodist Church, Lindstrom MN

Reports to: Worship Team Chair/Pastor Employment Type: Part-time/Contract

Position Overview:

The accompanist will provide musical accompaniment during worship services, special events, and rehearsals, enhancing the spiritual experience of the congregation through music.

Key Responsibilities:

- Worship Services: Play the piano for weekly services, including hymns, praise songs, and special music selections.
- This role is for 2 Sundays per month, but occasionally help may be needed for holidays (Thanksgiving, Christmas, and Holy Week) on weekday evenings.
- The accompanist ought to plan to arrive a ½ hour prior to the start of service (currently 8:30 for 9:00 am service) to get situated, and coordinate with other musicians, worship leader (typically pastor), and A/V techs.
- **A wonderful addition would be if the piano player would have the ability to vocally lead the congregational singing from the piano occasionally.
- **Musical Arrangements:** Collaborate with the Worship Team Chair/Pastor to select and arrange music for congregational singing (typically 3 per week). Also select appropriate pieces for prelude, postlude (can be closing hymn reprise), offertory (if not bells or choir that week), and communion.
- Congregational hymns should be largely familiar to the congregation

- Ideally, song selections support the service theme, sermon topic, or scripture, but this is not mandatory.
- **Special Events:** Provide piano music for church choir and other church events as needed if part of rotation week.
- **Community Engagement:** Support music ministry by engaging with congregants and fostering a welcoming atmosphere.
- Coordinate with other FUMC musicians to make sure all Sundays in a month are covered. Ideally we will follow a regular monthly rotation, but some flexibility is appreciated.

Qualifications:

- Proficiency in piano performance, with a strong understanding of various musical styles (hymns, contemporary Christian music).
- · Ability to read music and play by ear.
- · Strong communication and interpersonal skills.
- Flexibility in adapting to the needs of the church and its music ministry.

Additional Information:

- Expected hours will vary based on service schedule and special events, per weekly rotation
- A background check may be required.
- Compensation will be commensurate with experience.
