

Focus on Missions!

Lindstrom First UMC Mission priorities:

- Promotes the Great Commission (spreading the gospel)
- Supports persons or an organization that is doing good work and is fiscally sound
- Shares a connection with our congregation

Other considerations:

- Mission Sunday is generally the second Sunday of each month.
- Typically a speaker (including video presentation as appropriate) is given about 5 minutes to present information about the organization. The mission presentation is usually early in the order of the service (or at least before the offering is taken). If there is no specific speaker, the Pastor may present the information.
- Offering is collected in Mission Sunday envelopes (inserted in the bulletin). Checks may be made to FUMC and one check is sent from the church to the mission organization. (Any checks made directly to the organization are also sent, and the amount credited to the mission offering).
- An article about the mission organization is usually printed in the monthly newsletter. The deadline is the third Tuesday of each month. Information should be emailed to the church office prior to the deadline in a format ready for publication.
- A short paragraph about the organization should be available for printing in the bulletin. This may be emailed to the church office by Thursday at noon the preceding week. This is generally a short portion of the newsletter article.
- A written mission report summary for the previous month is due to the outreach committee before their meeting the second Tuesday of each month. (Usually shared by email)
- Additional mission opportunities may be appropriate during the year as additional needs arise. These should be discussed with the Pastor prior to presentation during the service.

Missions Coordinator Responsibilities:

- Plan the focus missions for the year
- Present the missions to the congregation at least once a month, give updates about mission giving totals and how the money is making an impact. This could be the missions coordinator, a member of the congregation who is engaged with the mission, a video, or a speaker from the organization.
- Write the newsletter article about the focus mission and submit by the third Tuesday of the month prior
- Write the bulletin excerpt about the focus mission. This can be an update each week submitted by noon the Thursday before printing or can be the same each week and can be submitted with the newsletter article.
- Report to the outreach committee on missions ministry the second Tuesday of each month or prior to their meeting.
- Coordinate service opportunities, speakers, collection drives (food, school supplies, etc) as appropriate
