Feed My Starving Children (FMSC) is a christian non-profit whose mission is that "Through God, FMSC will strive to eliminate malnutrition and starvation in children throughout the world by helping to instill compassion in a generation that hears and responds to the cries of those in need until all are fed." They believe that hope starts with food. Serving the world's most undernourished populations, FMSC works with food distribution partners that stay with communities for the long haul, empowering them to move from relief to development. MannaPack meals are developed by food science and nutrition professionals to supplement nutritional needs and reduce problems with malnutrition. Nutrition allows children to grow, thrive and develop to their full potential. FMSC has sent food to 110 countries since 2009.


