New business

Will do a workshop on how to understand different pastor from different cultural background. Bible study recommended by CS Laurie, will make a decision on how we proceed with Bible study.

Stephen Ministry has been going well with Bob's leadership, but is currently on hold for a few lessons as we pray for Bob and his health journey. Stephen ministry is for specific case (health condition, divorce, etc) but due to aging nature of congregation and the loneliness individuals face, looking at other options such as new programming to support those individuals.

Website, branding, and communication: Pr. Jay had individuals take survey on branding, collected the data, the need is really about signage at the front, sign outside on road. 




